Schools Responsibilities:

E.H. Phillips will:

- 1. Provide high-quality curriculum in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement as follow:

 - Highly qualified teacher to implement the curriculum
 - Technology/Device for virtual/distance learning and information on internet options
 - Flexible office hours to assist family learning needs
- 2. Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Conferences will be held in November 2023 and March 2024. Also, provide zoom/virtual meetings as needed.
- 3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress. Report cards will be available online three times per year at the end of each trimester. (K-1 grades in trimesters 2 and 3 only)
- 4. Provide parents/guardians reasonable access to staff. Staff members will be available via e-mail, by phone, or scheduled meetings. - 5. Provide parents' opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and to observe classroom activities as described in the school handbook.
- 6. Provide translation services and provide documents in accessible languages

Parent Responsibilities:

Parents will support their children's learning in the following ways:

- Monitor student attendance
- Ensure schoolwork (including cyber learning) and homework is complete
- Monitor time on television and electronic devices
- Volunteer at the school or in the classroom. Join the PTO.
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to your child's education
- Promoting positive use of your child's extracurricular time
- Staying informed about your child's education and communicating with the school by reading all notices from school or district and responding in a timely manner.
- Serving, when available, on parent discussion groups.
- Attending school-sponsored workshops
- Cyber Learning-provide appropriate space for distance learning at home, utilize teacher office hours for assistance, respond to teacher communication

Student Responsibilities:

Students at E.H. Phillips will share the responsibility to improve their academic achievement and achieve Pennsylvania's high standards. Specifically, students will:

- Do their homework (including distance-learning work) every day and ask for help when needed
- Read and practice math facts every day outside of school time
