Cal Ripken Baseball

PHR Baseball has joined with the Paxtonia Athletic Association, West Hanover Baseball Association and Dauphin Baseball Association to form the Central Dauphin Baseball Association League that will play as patched members of Cal Ripken Baseball. Our new league is chartered under the Cal Ripken Baseball governing body and will allow our players to play in a league against teams comprised of friends from within the Central Dauphin High School boundaries.

Our TBall level for ages 5-6 is designed for a fun, positive experience with an introduction to baseball. At the Rookie level for ages 7-8, we use a combination of spring-loaded pitching machines while introducing kids to pitching at ages 7-8 which better prepares the players for the advanced levels. Our Majors level teams are transitioning over to playing on a 50/70 size field rather than the antiquated small traditional size little league field. At 50/70, kids learn how to take leads, hold runners on, pitch out of the stretch, avoid balks, and other aspects of "real baseball." The 50/70 option is safer, more fair, and a more advanced form of baseball that better prepares the players for the next level. Most importantly, the kids of all skill levels love it!
