

CDSB Message Regarding Spectator Attendance at Sporting Events - September 22, 2020

Due to the Governor's limitations on the number of people at gatherings (25 indoors and 250 outside), the District is limiting the number of people who can attend fall sporting events. Although this will affect all fall sports at the District, it will have the greatest impact on football and volleyball.

FOOTBALL AND VOLLEYBALL

Unfortunately, given the Governor's restrictions, all spectators are prohibited from attending football and volleyball games. The current limited spectator numbers will only accommodate home and visiting teams, a limited number of band members, cheerleaders, security staff, essential staff, district staff and media.

Regarding football, spectators will be prohibited from entering Landis Field and from standing near the fence surrounding the stadium. No tailgating will be permitted. Campus will be closed at 5:30 pm on game days and the police will require anyone on site to leave so that we do not exceed the 250 person capacity. No vehicles will be permitted on school property.

ALL OTHER SPORTS

All other fall sports will also have to comply with the Governor's gathering limitations. Spectators will be permitted to attend those sporting events, so long as we can accommodate them within the limits (25 indoors and 250 outside).

BROADCASTING OF FOOTBALL GAMES AND OTHER SPORTING EVENTS

All of us at the District understand that these limitations are frustrating and disappointing for many. We are working to find a way to broadcast our football games and other sporting events to allow students, families, and the community to enjoy the accomplishments of and cheer on our student athletes. More information will be coming on this exciting development.
