<p><b>Hybrid:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Student split into 2 groups. Only one half of the students will be in the school buildings at one time to ensure social distancing can occur within classrooms</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students will receive in-person instruction from their assigned CDSB teachers in the school buildings 2 consecutive days per week (Group A: Mondays &amp; Tuesdays; Group B: Wednesdays &amp; Thursdays)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students will participate in distance learning 3 days per week (Group A: Wednesdays, Thursdays, &amp; Fridays; Group B: Mondays, Tuesdays, &amp; Fridays)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Distance learning will include a combination of live instruction, recorded/online content, and print material assignments posted on Google Classroom or Canvas</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Access to supports and enrichment from a CDSB instructional specialist, counselor and/or gifted support teacher</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Delivery of Special Education <li><input type="checkbox"/> Live instruction of the CDSB academic, behavioral and social emotional learning curricula will be delivered by the student's teacher multiple times per week via online and print materials</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Recorded lessons of the CDSB curriculum from a CDSB teacher and/or online content will be available for viewing at the student's convenience</li> CDSB curriculum from a CDSB teacher and/or online content will be available for viewing at the student's convenience</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students will interact online with grade level peers</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students may participate in instrumental lessons with a CDSB teacher via Zoom</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> If there is a school closure, students will remain with virtual class/teacher</li> </ul> <p><b>High School:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Recorded lessons of the CDSB curricula from a CDSB teacher will be available for viewing at the student's convenience</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Instructional support and assistance will be available from a CDSB teacher during office hours</li> <li><input instruction with tutoring assistance available from the online teacher from the outside curriculum provider</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Courses are aligned to the PA standards, but not to the CDSB Curriculum sequence of instruction</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students will have supports from a CDSB advisor and administrator</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Expected to complete 30 lessons per week (5 lessons per course, with 6 maximum courses)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Completion of work counts as attendance</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Grading is based on assignments, quizzes and assessments</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Grades are reflected on CDSB Report Cards</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> High School student's grades count towards GPA but not class rank</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Parents/Guardians will have the option to pick up grab and go breakfasts/lunches at designated locations</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students will stay enrolled in the Central Dauphin School District</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students may participate in extracurricular activities at their school buildings of record</li> </ul>
