

The Pennsylvania Department of Health (DOH) has directed school districts to communicate with the state regarding potential school shutdowns. During the 2022-2023 school year, if a positive case occurs in a District building, an individual school notification letter will be sent on the last day of that school week. This letter will contain the total number of individual cases that have been reported during that week. If no cases are reported in a building, a letter will not be sent.
