

Student Friendly Acceptable Use Translation Policy

Respect for Privacy: I will respect the right to the privacy of others.

Respect for Property: I will respect the property of others, including the school. I will make no changes to, or delete computer programs, files, or information belonging to others.

Respect for Ownership: I will respect the rights of others to earn a living for their work. While on the District's network, I will use only computer software, files or information that the District owns or is in the public domain and that I have permission to use. I will only make copies of computer files and information that I own or I have written.

Respect for Others and the Law: I will only use computers, software and related technologies for educational purposes, that are not harmful (physically, financially, or otherwise) to others or others' property and that are within the law.

I will use only my assigned account. If my account is not accessible I will contact my teacher for assistance.

I will not view, use, or copy passwords, data or images that I am not authorized to see or use.

I will not distribute private, offensive or hurtful information about others over the Internet and I will report to my teacher or an administrator if I see it occur.

I will not get together with anyone I meet on the Internet without first checking with and getting permission from my parents and/or a teacher, as appropriate.

I will follow the directions of the teachers, staff and administrators and observe all posted network security rules.

I will report any security risks or violations to a teacher or an administrator.

I will not destroy or damage data, networks, equipment, images or other resources that do not belong to me.
