

## CDS D ImPACT Information

- ImPACT is a neurocognitive test which is used to aid in the detection and treatment of sports concussions. ImPACT tests are administered prior to participation in sport to create a baseline for each athlete. This baseline can be used to aid in an athlete's return to play after a concussion. The test does not go on your student athletes transcripts and is not graded. Visit [www.impacttest.com](http://www.impacttest.com) for more information.
- All student athletes will complete a baseline ImPACT test their 9<sup>th</sup> grade year prior to participation in sport.
- Any student athlete who is new to CDS D or does not have an ImPACT test on file, regardless of grade, will complete a baseline ImPACT test prior to participation in sport.
- Any middle schools student athlete competing at the high school level (Junior High or 9<sup>th</sup> Grade) will complete a baseline ImPACT test prior to participation in sport.
