The Central Dauphin Cross Country Booster Association will be offering two scholarships to senior student-athletes who have participated in cross-country. College scholarships awarded to these senior student-athletes will be based on available funding and will be at least a minimum of \$500 each. Scholarships will be presented to one boy and one girl who participated in cross-country. Senior boys and girls meeting the criteria listed on the application form will have the opportunity to apply for one of scholarship.

The recipients of these scholarships will be announced at the Cross Country Banquet in November and at the Senior Awards presentation in May.

**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES**

- Only senior cross-country will be considered for a scholarship.
- The scholarship selections will be determined by the Cross Country Booster Association Scholarship Committee. Factors such as citizenship, commitment, program involvement, dedication, sportsmanship and team spirit will determine to whom the scholarships are offered.
- The scholarship entitles the student to receive credit for tuition, books, lab fees, or other academic cost, and room and board when housed under the control of the educational institution involved. Personal allowances or expense monies to the recipient of the scholarship are not permitted.
- A copy of verification of acceptance to an educational institution must be submitted before award payment will be issued. The educational program must be designed to take one or more years to complete.
- The scholarship checks for the winners will be presented to the winners (payable jointly to the scholarship recipient and the educational institution chosen by the winner) by the Cross Country Booster Association Scholarship Committee.
- If an individual is offered a scholarship and chooses not to continue his/her education within one year, or leaves the educational institution for any reason, and the funds of this scholarship remain a credit to his/her account, the educational institution involved shall return the balance of the scholarship to the Cross Country Booster Association, PO Box 6051, Harrisburg, PA 17112
