STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

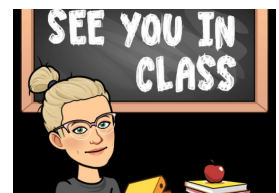
Students will be expected to maintain a daily planner to write down homework assignments. We also expect that they are checking their CDSD email accounts regularly.

WELCOME

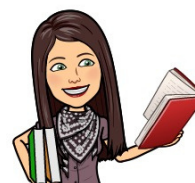

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Students will be provided with a planner from the school. They are expected to record homework assignments and upcoming tests each day.

- All teachers are using Canvas for our Learning Management system. Students are expected to check their class agendas daily.

HOW PARENTS CAN HELP

- Make sure your child has a supply of pencils throughout the year.
- Check the teacher's homework webpage and Canvas for updated assignments, projects, and upcoming exams.
- Monitor your child's grades in each class using the Home Access Center.
- Keep an open dialogue with your child about the social and academic aspects of middle school.
- Contact teachers with any questions or concerns.
- Computer and Internet access at home is not required but is very helpful for students to complete assignments.
- **Students are required to bring their district issued electronic devices to class each day. They will be taken out only at the direction of their teacher.**
- If students are assigned textbooks they are responsible for returning the same book at the end of the year or face an obligation.
