- 4. Provide parents/guardians reasonable access to staff. Staff members will be available via e-mail, by phone, or scheduled meetings. Contact information for each school is available on the District Website, www.cdschools.org., and HAC (Home Access Center), and teachers will use a messaging tool/app for parents
- 5. Provide parents' opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activates as described in the school handbook.
- 6. Monthly informational newsletter from principals.
- 7. Provide translation services and provide documents in accessible languages.
- 8. Have an open-door policy to meet with and speak to families at their request or as soon as possible at the schedule and availability of the principal.

Parent Responsibilities:

Student Responsibilities:
