



Central Dauphin School District Dress Code

Appropriate dress is that which is not offensive or does not present a safety hazard or disruption to the learning environment. Clothing which advertises or promotes the use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, sexual innuendos, or violence is **not appropriate**. Hats, sunglasses and coats may **not** be worn during the school day. Hats and outerwear worn to school must be kept in lockers. All headgear such as hats, hoods, headbands, visors, handkerchiefs, etc. are **not** permitted.

Students in violation of the dress code will be immediately required to change to appropriate attire. If necessary, parents will be called to bring proper clothing, so that the student may resume his or her regular schedule. **Repeated violations of the dress code will result in extended disciplinary consequences.**

Cooperation on the part of the students and parents is appreciated. Students should take pride in their education and arrive to school dressed appropriately and prepared to learn. Defiance of administrative directives will be dealt with in accordance to the behavior guidelines outlined in the Student Code of Conduct.

Prohibited Items:



No tank tops or shirts that expose underarms.

Shirts must cover back and front torso.



Clothing with holes or rips cannot reveal undergarments or private areas.



The length of shorts, skirts or dresses, may **not** be excessively short.



Pajamas (tops and/or bottoms) are **not** appropriate.

Footwear with wheels or slippers is **not** permitted.



All undergarments must be completely covered.
