Over the next several weeks, we will be learning about **money** in math! The information below will help you to support your child as they learn these exciting, yet important first grade math skills.

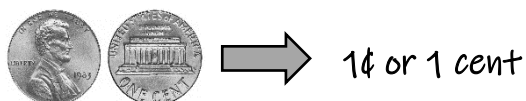
The **GOAL**:

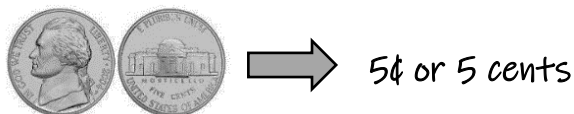

Identify the value of coins.

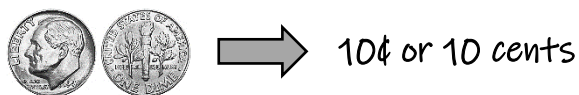

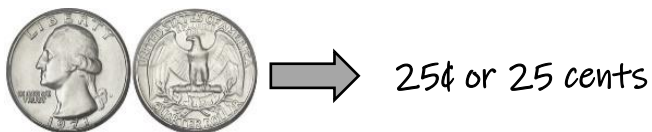
NICKEL



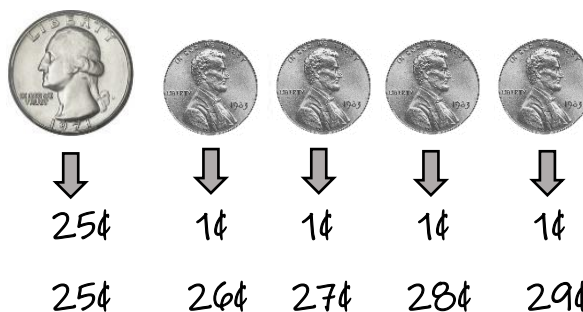
DIME



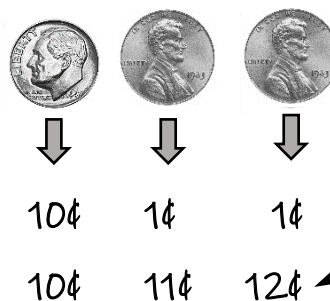

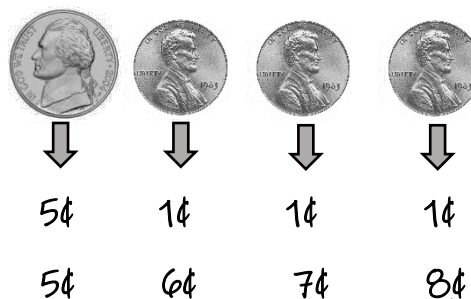
Count coin combinations:
